TUROA YOUTH TROPHY

Keith & Heather Wratt have kindly donated the Turoa Youth Trophy to encourage young people to show Dexters.

This Trophy will be presented for the first time at the end of the 2011/2012 show season.

An application form to enter for the Turoa Youth Trophy is available from the DCSNZ Website or from DCSNZ Council's Showing & Judging portfolio holder.

Points will be allocated to placings/prizes as follows:

1st place: 5 points 2nd place: 4 points 3rd place: 3 points 4th place: 2 points Reserve Champion: 7 points Champion: 10 points Supreme Champion: 15 points The show season begins in October & ends in April with the Auckland Royal Easter Show.

At the end of the show season the Turoa Youth Trophy will be awarded to the young person who has accumulated the most points over the show season.

The winner will be announced at the AGM each year.

A new Trophy will be purchased for presentation each year.

The Trophy will be engraved & is to be kept outright by the recipient.

Criteria:

- Entrants (or their families) do not have to be financial members of the DCSNZ.
- Entrants must be aged 18yrs or under on 1st October.
- Entry may be in any class at any A&P Show &/or official show.
- Prizes must have been won showing Dexter cattle.
- Each entry must include placings/prizes won only in the previous show season.
- Prizes must have been won by the entrant handling the animal in the ring.
- Prizes may have been won by the entrant over several shows.

- Prizes may have been won by the entrant showing several animals.

– In Group classes, where the entrant is one of several handlers, the placing won by the group may be included for the Turoa Youth Trophy.

- Cups & other trophies won at shows do not qualify for points towards the Turoa Youth Trophy.

- Entry must be on the official entry form & must include: Name of the show, class entered, registered name of animal & the placing/prize (ie Champion, 1st, 2nd, etc).

- A copy of entries must be sent to DCSNZ Council's Showing & Judging portfolio holder by the young person or his/her parent.

– Entries must be received by May 31st for the previous show season.
